

Employees of the Washington Emergency Management Division received an award April 26 from the Fort Lewis Fisher House for the employees' contribution of \$913 to Fisher House in the memory of **Allan Josue**, an EMD telecommunications planner who died June 11, 2006, in Hawaii. "It is our understanding that Allan, as a retired service member and Veteran, would have been greatly honored by your collective contributions. These funds will go to support our facilities that provide lodging for the visiting families of our wounded service members," the award read.
